





- A graphical development tool
- Powered by Google's Blockly programming language
- No special software needed, only a browser

### **Blocks Programming Webinar Series**

- Head FTA Jim Rumbaugh hosting again this season
- Designed to help rookie FTC teams get started with using BLOCKS to program the robot
- Also good for experienced teams who want to learn more about robot programming

### Pennsylvania FTC Championship



- The Pennsylvania FTC Championship Tournament
  - 48 Teams, 2 Divisions, 4 Fields
- 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> day event
  - Saturday (½ day): Judging and Inspections
  - Sunday (all day): Competition and Awards Ceremony
  - Location: Red Lion Area Senior High School
- Qualify through Pennsylvania FTC Qualifiers
  - Team must not have already advanced to FIRST Championship (Worlds) through another region
- 7 Teams advance to the FIRST Championship in Detroit

### The Pinnacle Pennsylvania FTC Event!

- The FIRST Consent and Release Form is required for all students, mentors, coaches, and volunteers at all Pennsylvania FTC Workshops, Scrimmages, Qualifiers, and State Championship
  - Electronic or paper form acceptable. If paper, it must be presented at each event
  - For students, form must be signed by parent or legal guardian not coach
- Those without signed a FIRST C&R Form are welcome to watch the event from the stands, but may not participate in the event
  - Not allowed in the Pits or in the Competition area

### **Slack Workspace**



- New Slack Workspace for Pennsylvania FTC Coaches and Mentors
  - Slack is a popular persistent chat tool used by many organizations
  - Adults affiliated with a team may join this Slack Workspace
  - Students are not allowed to join
  - Workspace supported by key Pennsylvania FTC volunteers
- Ask questions and share your expertise
  - Mechanical, hardware, software, judging, coaching tips, etc.
  - Pennsylvania FTC season and event questions
  - Note: Game rule questions are to be asked/answered in the FTC Game Forum



### **Game Manual 1 Updates**



- Human Player
  - One Human Player per alliance at field. Alliance decides which team provides Human Player before coming to field (e.g. at queuing table).

### • Alliance Markers

- Team is responsible for creating and bringing to the field 2.5" red square and 2.5" blue circle Alliance Markers.
- Red/Blue alliance flags are no longer used.

### • Team Scoring Element

- Current season's *Scoring Elements* may not be used as the *Team Scoring Element*.
- ...as well as several other changes! Be sure to read Game Manual 1.



### Pennsylvania Child Protection Laws Affects both Adults Affiliated with a Team and Event Volunteers



### **Pennsylvania Teams**

#### Qualifiers

- 1<sup>st</sup> Preference > Registered List assuming space available
- $2^{nd}$  Preference >  $2^{nd}$  Priority Waitlist
- $3^{rd}$  Preference >  $3^{rd}$  Priority Waitlist
- ... and so on

### **Out of State Teams**

#### Qualifiers

- Offset is TWO
- 1<sup>st</sup> Preference > 3<sup>nd</sup> Priority Waitlist
- $2^{nd}$  Preference > 4<sup>rd</sup> Priority Waitlist
- $3^{rd}$  Preference > 5<sup>th</sup> Priority Waitlist
- ... and so on

### Same as Last Season

**Qualifier Preferences, Registered Lists and Wait Lists** 

When registering for Qualifiers, consider award and advancement rules if you plan to compete in other states or regions



### Awards and Advancement in Game Manual Part 1

#### 7.2 Eligibility for Judged Awards

Teams are eligible to be considered for all Judged Awards except the Inspire Award ... at <u>any one of the</u> <u>first three events</u> they participate in at each of the following levels.

• League Tournament • Qualifying Tournament • Super Qualifying Tournament • Championship Tournament

#### 7.2.1 Inspire Award Eligibility

Teams that have won the Inspire Award at another event of the same level, <u>regardless of the region</u>, cannot be considered for the Inspire Award or as an Inspire Award Finalist at additional events at that level.

#### 7.3 Eligibility for Advancement

Teams are eligible for advancement at any one of the first three events they participate in at any of the following levels, **regardless of the region**.

• League Tournament • Qualifying Tournament • Super Qualifying Tournament • Championship Tournament

### Award and advancement opportunities now consider events participated in across all states and regions
